


Alberta Adventure Divers – Apr. 16, 2023

Discover Scuba: This grade 8 class had an excellent morning of diving in the pool!




May 27&28: Expedition to a new lake: Bright Swan Lake, SK.

We've heard about White Swan Lake in northern Saskatchewan for some time.

- Town pilings from a dam; Underwater artifacts
- Is dove by the Saskatoon dive club; Vis is better early in the season
- Can camp, or stay at the rustic resort

We decided to make a weekend event and check this lake out on the last weekend in May. Vance, Tammi, David and Connie have booked cabins. We also have a cabin with room for a single female to join! We will bring our red boats to access the dive site.

The resort has dropped any cancelation fee as they know we are coming for scuba and this will



depend on the ice being off. The restaurant will be open, and the cabins have an equipped kitchenette and a bbq on the deck. We do need to bring bedding and bath towels.
