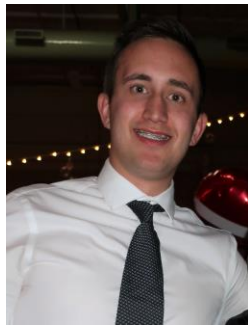
June dives – dive season is open!

- Do you have your scuba bingo card yet? Every card is different. If you want us to bring some to dive night, let Dan know. Only \$10/card, and there are prizes!

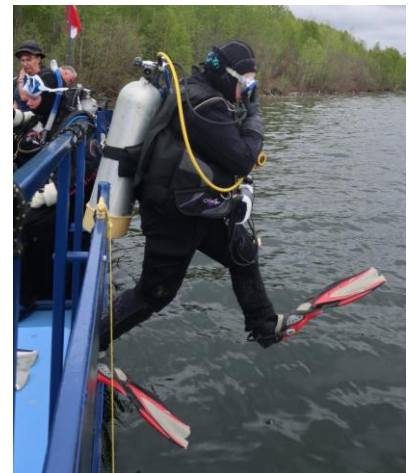
June 24: Zombie Dive

- * Buddy or witness to initial & date in the square to verify the activity is completed
- * Diving and non-diving activities to complete
- * Some activities are in Clear Lake, other activities can be in any lake or ocean, but not a bathtub, to be clear.
- * Drop off your card at the dive store or bring it to the pumpkin dive
- * All prizes awarded at the pumpkin dive
- * Cards available at the dive store - \$10 to enter the challenge.
- * You may work on more than one card in the season – the squares are randomly generated so every card is unique!
