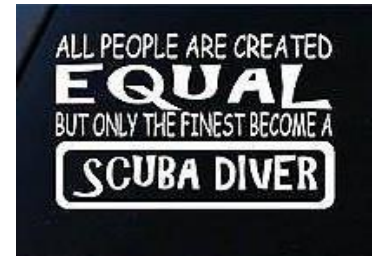




## Alberta Adventure Divers Spring, 2023

If you are interested in scuba lessons or have friends or future dive buddies that are interested, join us for these spring dates.

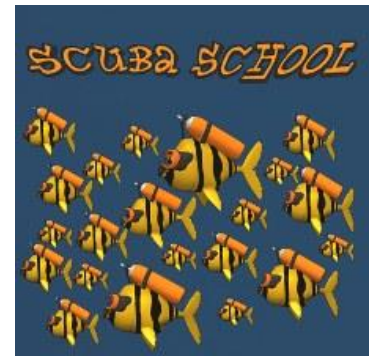
Note: we typically teach specialty training and host fun dive events later in the summer. The Open Water course is taught early in the season.



### Open Water course dates: Pool sessions

**May 5 to 7:**  
Fri. 6:30 to 8:30  
Sat. 10 to 12 and 2  
to 4  
Sun. 10 to 12

**June 3 & 4:** open  
water dives at Clear Lake: full days



### Open Water course instructor message:

The PADI instructional program offered at Alberta Adventure Divers is very strong. As resilient and experienced instructors, we have the patience and skills to teach students to enjoy diving and succeed in the course. David, Mark, Kevin B and I love to teach the Open Water dive course. Diving can open up many opportunities to learn about the underwater aqua-system and enjoy travel opportunities throughout the world.

### Open Water course details – theory, confined water skills, open water dives:

Many of our students have already completed the theory already; they can brush up on it a bit and begin the confined water skills in the Lloydminster pool. The Red Deer group uses a local pool and lake!

Open water dives are completed at Clear Lake, the first weekend in June.



### Save the open water course dates:

We request our students put every effort into making these dates work. If you can't make an open water session, we can re-schedule it to a dive night, or alternate date. We are promoting this course, as after this we get busy with specialty courses and dive events.

**Dry Suit diving:** We encourage students to learn in a dry suit. The dry suit course is included in the deluxe package. Certainly in May, but even in July and August the water temperature warrants a dry suit. All our pro staff dives in dry suits all summer. Is it more difficult to dive in a dry suit? No, diving is different in a dry suit, but not harder.

**Open Water course registration:** Contact the dive store for more information, to sign up and begin theory.

**Red Deer:** Mark's dive schedule is to teach Open Water confined water dives at a pool on Tuesday evenings in March/April, with Open Water dives early in the summer. The rest of the summer will focus on specialty dives at Twin Lakes.
