Ice Diving: Are you looking for your next challenge as a certified scuba diver? We are planning an ice dive course on March 5 & 6 at Clear Lake. The weather forecast is fantastic!



We will be cutting a hole through the ice to get to the water, and then will dive under this ice.

Drysuits are generally recommended, though there are some people who ice dive in wetsuits. After all, the water in the lake cannot drop below 0 degrees Celsius, because if it did, it would be ice.

There is special training to do diving like this. If you are not a certified Ice Diver, sign up for our PADI Ice Diver Specialty Course. This is a hands on course – no knowledge reviews to prepare, no exam – learn by doing!! There is theory to learn – how to ice dive safely, how to cut the hole, and so on. Then we cut the hole, and complete three course dives over the weekend.

Ice diving is an adventure ... and we did name our store with adventures like this in mind!!




The prerequisite is Advanced certification, and you must be 18 years old with a great sense of adventure. Cost: \$290.


