

## PADI Rescue Diver & O<sub>2</sub> Provider courses Sept. 16 & 17, 2023



Most who have completed rescue say that every diver should have this course! This course is not only about dive skills, it is about preventing and avoiding difficult or dangerous situations. You will learn about self-awareness, and knowing the best actions to take in the case of a dive situation. Many of our students have come back and reported that the situational awareness lessons they learned have helped in non-diving events. Bonus: PADI O<sub>2</sub> Provider certification is included in course price!



## **Prerequisites:**

\*First aid with CPR within 2 years: If you do not have this; contact the shop; we can incorporate it into the course (cost of \$100).

\*The Advanced course is not required, but three adventure dives including Navigation is required. \*Rescue E-learning: \$232

**Equipment:** Dive gear; lunch & snacks; dress for the weather.

- Create emergency assistance plan
- Dive skills and exercises Sun.: 10 am to 4 at Clear Lake
